What is K2L Cycleway?

K2L is a campaign calling upon Warwickshire County Council to build a dedicated off-road cycleway between Kenilworth and Leamington Spa by March 2022.

The proposed route would link Leamington Spa with the Kenilworth Greenway and National Cycle Route 52 to Warwick University. The K2L route, currently used by cyclists at their own risk, could be an easy and safe three mile commute or pleasant leisure ride.

We local volunteers and cycle groups, believe the K2L route is essential, and should be an integral part of the Warwickshire cycle network; providing an important step in the transition to a low carbon and healthy transport system for Warwickshire.

The route has been on the drawing board for over 20 years, but with increasing traffic and Royal Leamington Spa being listed as one of the most polluted areas in England, K2L is now urgent and necessary.
